Pool play format: 3 courts, 10 teams, 15 matches

1 pools of 4 teams, 2 pools of 3 teams, all pools playing 2 games to 25

Tournament Format: All teams advance. All teams must be ranked within their pools based on match percentage first. For any ties, use the tie-breaking procedure below. All first-place and second-place teams to the Gold playoffs. All third-place and fourth-place teams to the Silver playoffs. Playoff positions on the tournament brackets will be based on pool finish to avoid teams from the same pool playing each other in the first round.

Warm up – first warm up 4-4-4, thereafter 3-3, Coin Flip to determine first serve.

Tie breaking:

Two way tie

- a. Total games won-lost
- b. Head to head (in games won, if between two teams in one pool)
- c. Head to head (in point differential, same as above)
- d. Total point differential
- e. If tie is for 2<sup>nd</sup> place (Gold/Silver), 1 game to 15, otherwise coin flip

Three way tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place

- a. Top seed determined by overall point differential
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> place is determined by Two way tie breaking procedure.

Three way tie for 2<sup>nd</sup> place

- a. Top seed determined by total pt. differential; other 2 teams play 1 game to 15 pts (No cap). Winner of that plays top seed (of 3 tied teams) 1 game to 15 pts. Winner of 2nd game goes to Gold (Loser to Silver).

Playoffs:

Gold quarter and semi finals are 2 games to 25

Silver semifinals are 1 game to 25

Gold finals are best of 3

Silver Finals are 2 games to 25, point differential determines winner if tied, game to 15 if still tied.

Trophy awarded to Gold Champion
